- Must have a strong sense of ethics and integrity.
- Must have specific skills or expertise related to the committee's work.
- Must have good communication skills and the ability to engage with the community.
- Must be dedicated to attending meetings regularly and participating actively.

How Selection Works:



Once you submit your application to join an Advisory Committee, the selection process involves several key steps:

- 1. Our team will carefully review all submitted applications to ensure they meet the basic eligibility requirements and match the committee's needs.
- 2. Candidates are evaluated based on their relevant experience, skills, and commitment to the committee's objectives. We look for individuals who demonstrate a strong understanding of the committee's focus and a genuine enthusiasm for contributing to its goals.
