The Mobile County Health Department (MCHD) and its primary care division Family Health (FH) are observing **National Health Center Week** (NHCW) with special activities. The weeklong campaign is set for August 4 to 10. The purpose of this celebration is to raise awareness about the mission and accomplishments of America's health centers over the past five decades.

The theme for this year's NHCW is "Powering Communities Through Caring Connections." MCHD/FH has planned special events during NHCW to coordinate with the nation-wide "focus days" that showcase the innovative ways MCHD/FH provides high-quality health care and improving health outcomes.

<u>Sunday, August 4:</u> *Public Health in Housing Day* – MCHD/FH will initiate a social media campaign highlighting accessibility.
On Monday, August 5, Healthcare for the Homeless Day – MCHD/FH will initiate a social media campaign highlighting Family Health locations conveniently located throughout the community.

- <u>Tuesday, August 6:</u> *Agricultural Worker Health Day* MCHD/FH will highlight the Semmes Health Center and its importance within the community servicing agricultural and migrant workers. The Mobile City Council will also present a proclamation in observance of NHCW at 10:30 a.m.
- <u>Wednesday, August 7:</u> *Patient Appreciation Day* MCHD/FH will post, via social media, patient education information regarding common chronic conditions. "Thank You" banners will be placed at each Family Health location to convey our appreciation to our wonderful patients.
- <u>Thursday, August 8:</u> *Stakeholder Appreciation Day* MCHD/FH staff will be sending "thank you" notes and a special memento of appreciation to its Governing Council members, who oversee FH operations. The Mobile County Commission will also present a proclamation in observance of NHCW at 10 a.m.
- <u>Friday, August 9:</u> *Health Center Staff Appreciation Day* All MCHD/FH employees will receive a token of appreciation in honor of their hard work and dedication.
- <u>Saturday, August 10:</u> *Children's Health Day* MCHD/FH will host a back-toschool bash at its Keeler Memorial Building (251 North Bayou Street in Mobile) from 8 a.m. to noon. Free school supplies will be distributed, while supplies last. The goal is to raise awareness of the importance of children receiving the CDC recommended childhood vaccinations. Following Saturday's event, all Family Health locations will continue to prepare children to begin the upcoming school year with well child visits.

Join us at the community meeting on **Wednesday**, **August** 7, to learn about the current programs and future initiatives of our **Homeless Outreach Team**. This is a fantastic opportunity for those interested in giving back to our community and making a hands-on impact in helping the homeless.
