As many of you know, I have been very vocal about the need for more transparency throughout the affordable housing process in the City of Mobile. As this sentiment is also shared among all of my colleagues, the Mobile City Council held an Entitlement Committee meeting on Tuesday, June 11, 2024.

During this meeting, the City of Mobile's Senior Director of Neighborhood Development, James Roberts, will attend to provided the Council with an overview of recent Affordable Housing developments. Roberts will discuss the City's authority within the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development & Mobile Housing Authority Recovery Agreement, provide an update on the Mobile Housing Authority code citation, and summarize the role of the City's Tenant Advocate Inspector within Municipal Enforcement.

Keri Coumanis with the Department of Community Planning & Development was also present to give insight into the possible development of a Capital Cooperative District in our area.
