Dear Residents of District 2,

I hope this email finds you in great health and high spirits

I want to update you on the latest developments regarding the investigation into the allegations made by former Mobile Police Chief Paul Prine. On May 28, the Mobile City Council appointed Bradley, Arant, Boult, Cummings LLP to conduct an independent investigation into these serious allegations.

Leading this investigation are Bill Athanas and Daniel Fortune, both former federal prosecutors with extensive experience. During Tuesday morning's pre-Council meeting, we had a Zoom call with Mr. Athanas to discuss the scope and approach of the investigation. To ensure full transparency and independence, the law firm provided a conflict review, confirming they have no prior or current representation of Mayor Sandy Stimpson, Chief of Staff James Barber, Public Safety Director Rob Lasky, or former Chief Prine. The firm's last involvement in Mobile was in 2008, representing the Mobile Housing Authority.

The investigation is budgeted at \$200,000. It is our hope that this thorough and independent investigation will help us address the concerns that have been raised and move our city forward.
