The Committee Meeting of the Whole will convene at 8:30 a.m. to discuss the forthcoming investigation into public allegations against the Administration by former Mobile Police Chief Paul Prine. Later that day, at 1:00 p.m., the Economic, Cultural & Civic Development Committee will meet to receive updates from Amtrak on their proposed plans for a rail development project.

The Administrative Services Committee and Entitlement Committee meetings previously scheduled for May 28th have been canceled.

Both meetings will be held in the Mobile City Council conference room, located on the 9th floor of the South Tower of Government Plaza, 205 Government Street. These are working meetings, and no public comments will be taken.
